

2012/10/06 – Hope Area. Just One Continuous Flow: A passenger on a bus saw something strange in the Hope area at 7:35 p.m. on October 6, 2012. Here is what he reported:

I was on Greyhound bus number 1274 from Calgary going to Vancouver. I saw what I first thought to be a man wearing a dark brown ski suit with hood. Then I realized there was no apparent neck, face, hands, feet—or any indication of separate items of clothing; just on continuous flow. The left arm was slightly bent and swinging by its side. It was walking slowly upstream along the edge of the creek. It appeared to be looking at the ground ahead of it. The coat appeared smooth. My second thought was that it was someone pretending to be a sasquatch. If it was, he/she was not paying any attention to the traffic on the highway. As far as I know I was the only one who saw it. On the trip back to Calgary it was very dark and I was unable to identify the location of my sighting.
