

## **2017/01/29 – Sasquatch Provincial Park, Harrison. Big Figure**

**Standing Between Two Trees.** Four researchers saw what appears to have been a sasquatch on a slope at the entrance to Sasquatch Provincial Park on January 29, 2017 at 4:00 p.m. The oddity was about 100 feet away and was seen to be swaying from side to side. It was close enough to observe that it did not appear to have a neck and its head was set on its shoulders. Something was said to it and it moved its left arm to chest height. It then backed away and disappeared into the forest. An attempt was made to get to the spot by a fifth researcher who arrived later, but he was unable to do so.

The group made whooping sounds and got two high-pitched whoops back to the right and west of where the figure had been. A few minutes later the fifth researcher made a loud roaring sound and there was a reply to the northeast. It was very different from the first two vocalizations and was very loud even though distant. More vocalizations were made, but there were no further responses.

The group moved on to another location, but then returned. Thermal images were taken of the slope where the figure had been seen and a figure was seen that appeared to have a pointed head. When someone moved toward the slope, the figure ran up the hill from right to left: it was agreed that it was a sasquatch. It then went behind trees and disappeared. Not long after another thermal image was seen of something low to the ground, again a pointed head was observed. Some video of the first thermal images was taken, but a battery failure occurred. Full video of the second images was captured. The group left the area about 9:30 p.m.

Thomas Steenburg went to the sight with some of the group on February 1, 2017 and they got to the spot where the figure was seen. Rough footprints about 15 inches long were found of a left and right foot, and casts were made. A heel to heel measurement of the two prints was 6 feet, 7 inches.
