2012/06/16 — Pitt River Area. Covered in White Hair: An American visitor staying at the Pitt River Lodge informed that he sighted what he believes was a sasquatch on June 16, 2012 at about 4:00 p.m. The visitor had gone fishing in the Pitt River and observed a sasquatch covered in white hair on the south bank. He estimated its height at between 7 and 8 feet. It was ape-like in appearance and stood and moved on two legs. It came out of the trees and moved about for approximately one minute and then stepped back into the trees. The visitor did not see it again.



The Pitt River Lodge. The entire Pitt Lake and Pitt River area is very remote and other sasquatch reports have come from this area. Exploration is both difficult and dangerous because of the rugged terrain and dense wilderness.
