2014/07/01 - Salmon Arm Area, Trans-Canada Highway. "Like a Basketball Player": A truck driver (18-wheel rig) saw something strange on the highway at about 3:00 a.m. on July 1, 2014. He observed from a distance a very tall figure in the middle of the highway and when he approached it he put on his high beam. In this process, the oddity moved to the right of the highway and went into the trees. What the driver saw was hair-covered (medium brown hair), walked upright on two legs, and was well over 7 feet tall. As it went into the trees, it lifted an arm to clear branches. At this time, the driver was about 180 feet from the subject, which he could see clearly in his truck headlights. He commented that it was built like a basketball player—"at least 7, maybe 7 and a half feet tall." He guessed its weight to be 350 to 400 pounds and added, "it looked kind of thin." When asked if what he saw could have simply been a tall man, he responded, "Well yeah, but I think very unlikely unless you got a 7 foot tall basketball player covered head to toe in hair crossing the highway at three in the morning." The driver definitely feels that what he saw was a sasquatch.
