2014/07/26 - Vedder Mountain, Near Yarrow. Large Footprint—Possible Sasquatch: A man exploring forest service roads on Vedder Mountain found what he believes was a large footprint at about 2:30 p.m. on July 26, 2014. He was with his young daughter traveling in his car and a fresh game trail caught his attention. He parked his car and explored the trail whereupon he saw a large impression (footprint?) at the bottom of a bank in a ditch. The print was 15 inches long and 7.5 inches wide. It was implanted about 2 inches into the soil. He experimented with his own 13-inch foot (boot), applying his weight at 260 pounds, but could not get close to the depth of the print. He noted that the bank had flat areas as though a large flat foot had dug into it. He took photographs, left, and returned later with plaster to cast the print. He also followed the trail up the bank and into the forest, finding many areas of flattened earth and flattened moss.







These photographs were provided. That the print arched to the extent indicated in the cast was likely the result of plaster flow, but there was definitely an arch.
