

2016/06/10 – Weaver Creek, West Side of Harrison Lake.
“Strange Foot Tracks”: A local resident on his early morning walk saw “strange foot tracks” near Weaver Creek at about 5:00 a.m. on June 10, 2016. The tracks were along the trail near the bank of the creek. The resident informed his sister and she went to the spot and took cell phone photographs (not available at this writing). Thomas Steenburg was informed and he arrived at the site at about 9:00 a.m. Rain and traffic on the trail, along with dogs, had obliterated the tracks save one as seen below that measured between 11 and 12 inches long. The size of the track does not rule out a person walking the trail in bare feet; however, recent possible sasquatch sightings in this entire region, including Weaver Lake, might indicate that there was a sasquatch in the area.
